ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESMENT REGULATIONS

GoN 544, EIA Regulations - Listing Notice 1: List of Activities and Competent Authorities identified in terms of section of the NEMA Act was gazetted on the 18 June 2010. The purpose of the Notice is to identify activities that require environmental authorisations prior to commencement of the activity and to identify the competent authorities.

An activity directly related to our industry, the minimum requirement for having to do an EIA when constructing or expanding infrastructure for the storage and handling of Dangerous Goods in containers, i.e. storage-, working-, mixing- and measuring tanks, have been amended from "30 m³ but not exceeding 1000 m³" to "80 m³ but not exceeding 500 m³". It is important to remember that this is a minimum requirement and that anyone intending to construct or expand should still inquire from the relevant Authority whether or not other restrictions apply for the site where construction or expansion is required.
